NextEra Energy Resources, LLC proposes the 180-megawatt North Side Energy Center to power New York with clean, renewable energy.

North Side Energy Center, owned 100 percent by NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, has developed a proposal to establish a large-scale solar energy facility located in St. Lawrence County, New York. This project would be among the largest solar arrays on the East Coast, putting the North Country in the forefront of renewable energy technologies. North Side Energy Center would significantly contribute to New York's efforts to meet New York Governor Andrew Cuomo's renewable energy goals.

The proposed project would:

- » Generate up to 180 megawatts of solar energy, providing power for more than 40,000 homes
- » Provide the area with an important and unique opportunity to diversify its energy sources with clean, renewable energy
- » Reduce carbon emissions by an average of 150,000 tons annually -- this is the equivalent of taking more than 30,000 cars off the road
- » Create 250-325 construction jobs
